As you can tell from the photo, we are preparing for the fall planting. Last week we continued with our annual tradition of erecting a temporary shade house using PVC and rebar. The early green transplants certainly appreciate the smallest bit of direct sun relief. So with the end of July approaching we have already begun to act on seed ordering for the fall season, bed preparation for the direct seeding of root crops, and seeding in the shade house. We will play catch-up and maintain the rest of the week hopefully charging into August doing our best to balance the demands of two seasons.

We are engaged in the fall planting. Growing comfortably in the shade we have broccoli, kale, cauliflower, chard, collards, komatsuna, pac choi, fennel, cilantro, parsley, lettuce, and rutabagas. We also began a late succession of summer squash and cucumbers beneath the shade canopy, stretching the summer season into the early days of autumn.
